


KS2 Centre Curriculum Organiser

English. We ended last half term by reading the book 'Amazing' by Steve Antony. We will continue to use this book as a stimulus for our own writing. The Makaton actions will help us to recall the story and we will then make our own changes so that we become authors ourselves. We will use adjectives and adverbs in our writing and try to edit our final pieces carefully to check for any mistakes with punctuation.



We will continue to learn more about the zones of regulation to support us with managing our emotions.




Children will take part in 1:1 reading as well as guided reading sessions. Children are taught the six skills of reading through VIPERS – vocabulary, inference, predict, explain, retrieve and summarise. Example questions will be sent home for you to make use of at home as you read together.

Forest School. Every Friday afternoon we attend Forest School. As the autumn weather becomes increasingly cold, please make sure that you provide plenty of layers of clothing, including a warm hat and gloves. Suitable waterproof and cosy footwear is essential.



Maths. All children follow a programme of learning specific to their individual needs, depending on which year group curriculum they are accessing. All



children will have the opportunity to build up their knowledge of times tables and they can improve their speed and accuracy at home using Jack Hartman (YouTube) and Hit the Button.

Sensory Provision. Daily participation in a short Sensory Circuit prepares the children to engage effectively with the day ahead. The three sensory areas are alerting, organising and calming. Activities are planned accordingly. The children are divided into two groups and we take turns to use either the hall or the sensory room.



Fine Motor Skills. We work through a range of activities developed with the support of our OT. In our handwriting sessions we will focus on correct letter formation, trying to ensure our letters are of the correct size in relation to each other. We will try and use the lines in our books correctly.
